







You will see the big GRANVILLE ISLAND sign. Keep going straight, across the bridge.

Carousel Theatre is a bit further on the right, behind the trees








Bike Valet

It is there from the May long weekend till the September long weekend.


The bike valet will be around the corner in this parking lot


The bike valet is on your left.








Virtual visit of the performance space The washrooms

There are two accessible gender neutral washrooms. When you leave the room, they are across the hallway





There will be a baby change table in this corner





To go there, go back out the same door from before. Turn Right and right again. You will see the open door.








Theatre Guidelines

Two actors with egg-shaped lamps will come toward me to say hello. I can tell them my name if I want.








3. The mama bird








5. The bees

The bees will invite me to play with them on round green circles. I can stand up, or I can remain seated.








6. The caterpillars

The caterpillar puppets will dance. They will come close to me. The caterpillar puppet can climb onto me, or I can say no thank you.








7. The millipede

The actors will offer me colored sticks. They will invite me to play music with I can take a stick and make music, or I can say no thank you.








8. The night

9. DidgeridooI will hear the didgeridoo instrument vibrate.








10.The baby birds
